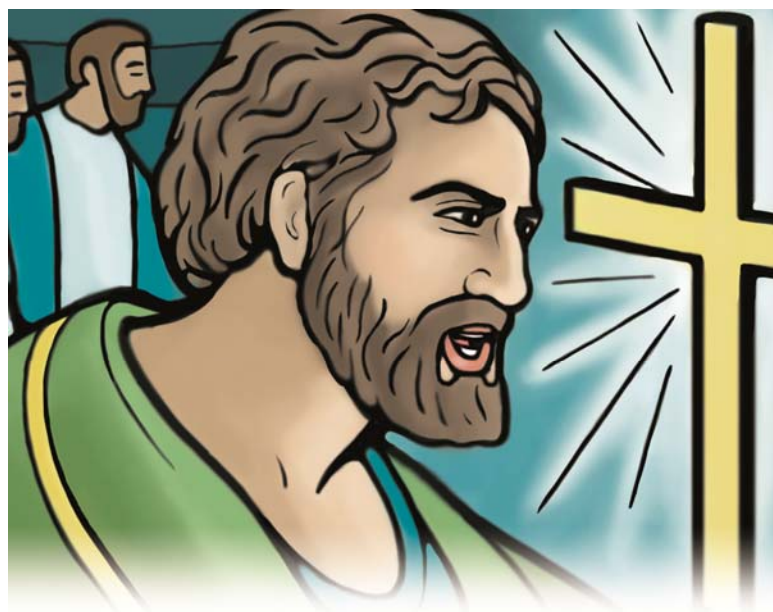

**Christian Relief Fund**

**Q** *Must I receive both the body and the blood of Christ to receive him fully?*

**A** In recent years there has been a renewed interest and practice of receiving the Eucharist under both forms or species, bread and wine. But this is not necessary to receive the Eucharistic presence of Christ. The Council of Trent taught that the presence of Christ in the Eucharist begins with the words of consecration and endures as long as the species of bread and wine subsist. Furthermore, Christ is present whole and entire in both species and in all parts of the species. So if the bread is broken the presence of Christ is not divided (CCC 1377). If one receives a larger portion of bread, they do not receive more Christ! In the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, paragraph 281 states, "Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it is distributed under both kinds." Paragraph 383 goes on to remind us that we are not deprived of any grace necessary for salvation when we receive Communion under one form.
