Parish Health Notes—*Distracted Driving* Each day in the United States, more than 9 people are killed and more than 1,153 people are injured in crashes that are reported to involve a distracted driver. Drivers on cell phones are four times more likely to be involved in an accident. Drivers talking on a cell phone can miss seeing up to 50% of their driving environment including pedestrians and red lights. This phenomenon is known as "inattention blindness." Driving and talking on a cell phone are both tasks that require a lot of thought. When doing both, your brain can't do either well. For example, it's nearly impossible to follow a TV show while speaking on the phone. Almost everyone has seen a driver distracted by a cell phone, but when you are the one who is distracted, you don't realize that driver is you. Five seconds is the average time your eyes are off the road while texting. When traveling at 55mph that's enough time to cover the length of a football field blindfolded. *There is no safe way to use a cell phone while driving.* www.cdc.gov.
