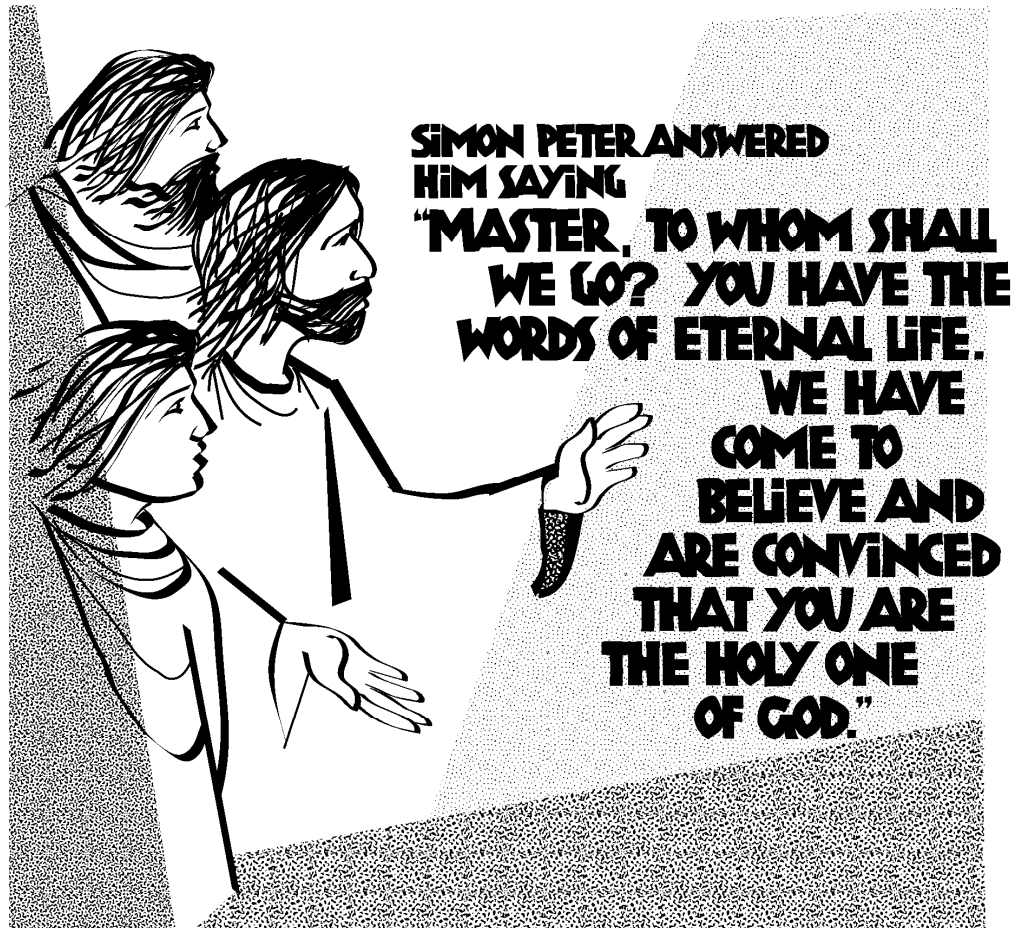

Bible Studies

A big "Welcome" to the new Bible Study participants. We will be offering "The Great Adventure Bible Timeline Study" again this year. Beginning September 17, (Thursdays), 6:30-8:00 pm. This study teaches the foundations. All other studies build on the knowledge you will gain from this study. An added plus is how Jeff Cavins will show you the truths and connections from the Old Testament with the New Testament, ex. Ark of Old Covenant (carrying types of Jesus), King David leapt for joy as Ark came to his house.
