Parish Health Notes:



Your body depends on water to survive. Every cell, tissue, and organ in your body needs water to work properly. For example, your body uses water to maintain its temperature, remove waste, and lubricate your joints. Water is needed for overall good health. Recognizing signs

of dehydration is important. They include:

- Little or no urine.
- Urine that is darker than usual.
- Dry mouth.
- Sleepiness or fatigue.
- Extreme thirst.
- Headache.
- Confusion.
- Dizziness or lightheadedness.
- No tears when crying.

Some people are at higher risk of dehydration, including people who exercise at a high intensity (or in hot weather) for too long, have certain medical conditions (kidney stones, bladder infection), are sick (fever, vomiting, diarrhea), are pregnant or breastfeeding, are trying to lose weight, or are not able to get enough fluids during the day. Older adults are also at higher risk. As you get older, your brain may not be able to sense dehydration. It doesn't send signals for thirst.

Don't wait until you notice symptoms of dehydration to take action. Actively prevent dehydration by drinking plenty of water.

Cemetery Collection. You will notice a Cemetery Collection Envelope in your offertory envelope packet. This annual collection allows us to maintain our Parish Cemetery. Budgeted expenses for the coming year are \$14,000.00. You can help our Parish in the important work of providing a good and comforting place for our deceased loved ones. You will find some cemetery collection envelopes in the Church. Perhaps you could share these envelopes with out of town relatives who might have loved ones buried in our cemetery.
