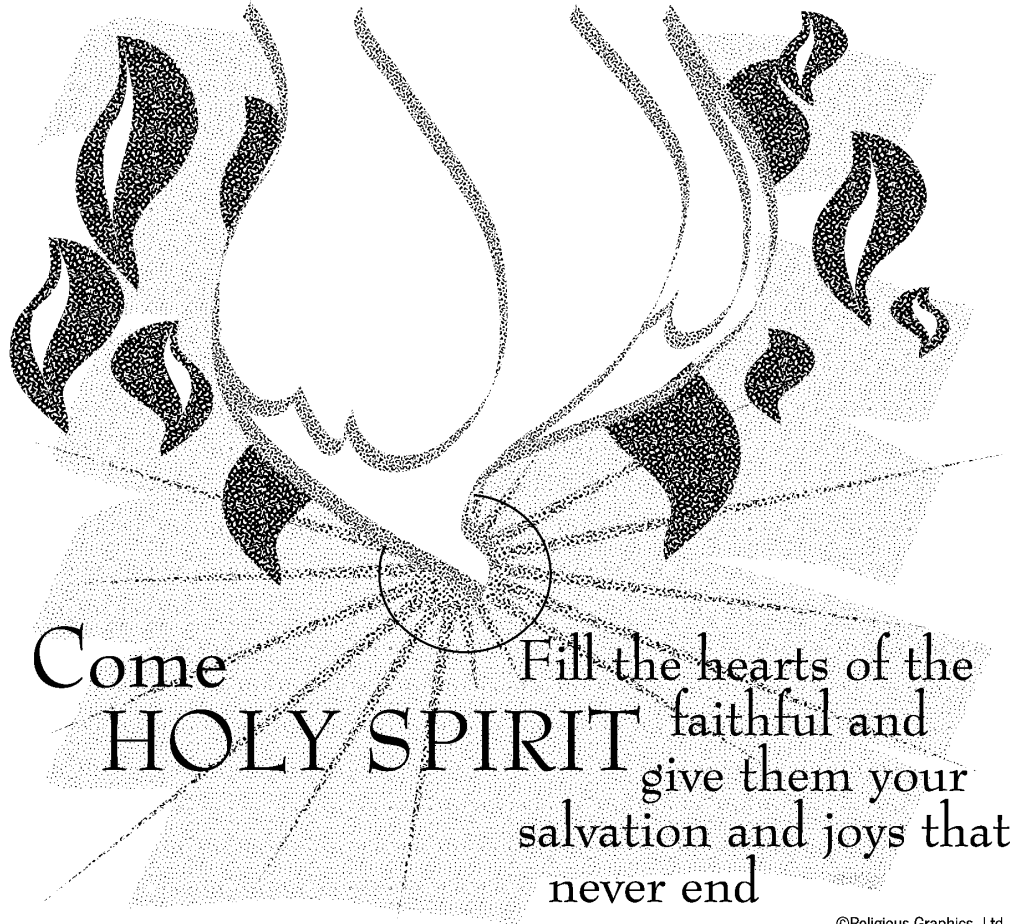

**Parish Health Notes**—Alcohol abuse kills 75,000 Americans each year. We encourage you to educate yourself and your loved ones about the dangers of drinking too much. **Common signs and symptoms of alcohol abuse include: Repeatedly neglecting your responsibilities at home, work or school because of your drinking. Using alcohol in situations where it's physically dangerous, such as drinking and driving, operating machinery while intoxicated, or mixing alcohol with prescription medication against doctor's orders. Experiencing repeated legal problems on account of your drinking.** For example, getting arrested for driving under the influence or for drunk and disorderly conduct. **Continuing to drink even though your alcohol use is causing problems in your relationships. Drinking is a way to relax or de-stress.** Many drinking problems start when people use alcohol to self-soothe and relieve stress.
