

Parish Health Notes—Arthritis is not just a disease of old age. Two-thirds of people with arthritis are under the age of 65, including 300,000 children. Three of the common diseases that make up arthritis are: *Osteoarthritis (OA)*, the most common form, is a progressive degenerative joint disease characterized by the breakdown of joint cartilage; *Rheumatoid Arthritis (RA)*, a systemic disease characterized by the inflammation of the membranes lining the joint and *Juvenile Arthritis (JA)* used to describe the many autoimmune and inflammatory conditions that can develop in children ages 16 and younger. Arthritis is the leading cause of disability in the United States. Arthritis is actually a more frequent cause of activity limitations than heart disease, cancer or diabetes. Endurance and resistance types of exercise provide considerable disease-specific benefits for people with osteoarthritis (OA) and rheumatic conditions. For every one pound of weight loss results in four pounds of pressure taken off each knee.
