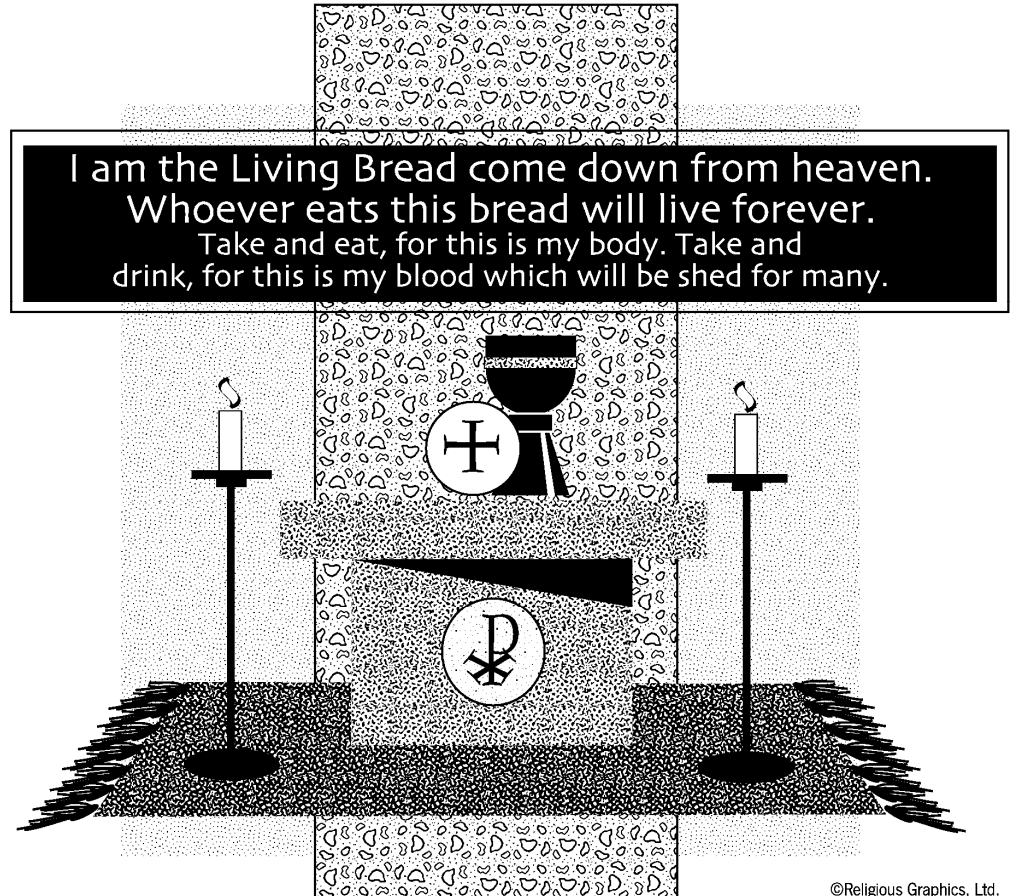

Parish Health Notes—Skin cancer is the most common form of cancer in the United States. One in five Americans will develop skin cancer in the course of a lifetime. One blistering sunburn in childhood or adolescence more than doubles a person's chances of developing melanoma later in life. A person's risk for melanoma also doubles if he or she has had five or more sunburns at any age. Many cases of skin cancer can be prevented by following these precautions: Avoid the sun during the middle of the day, wear sunscreen year-round, wear protective clothing, avoid tanning beds, become familiar with your skin so you'll notice changes.
