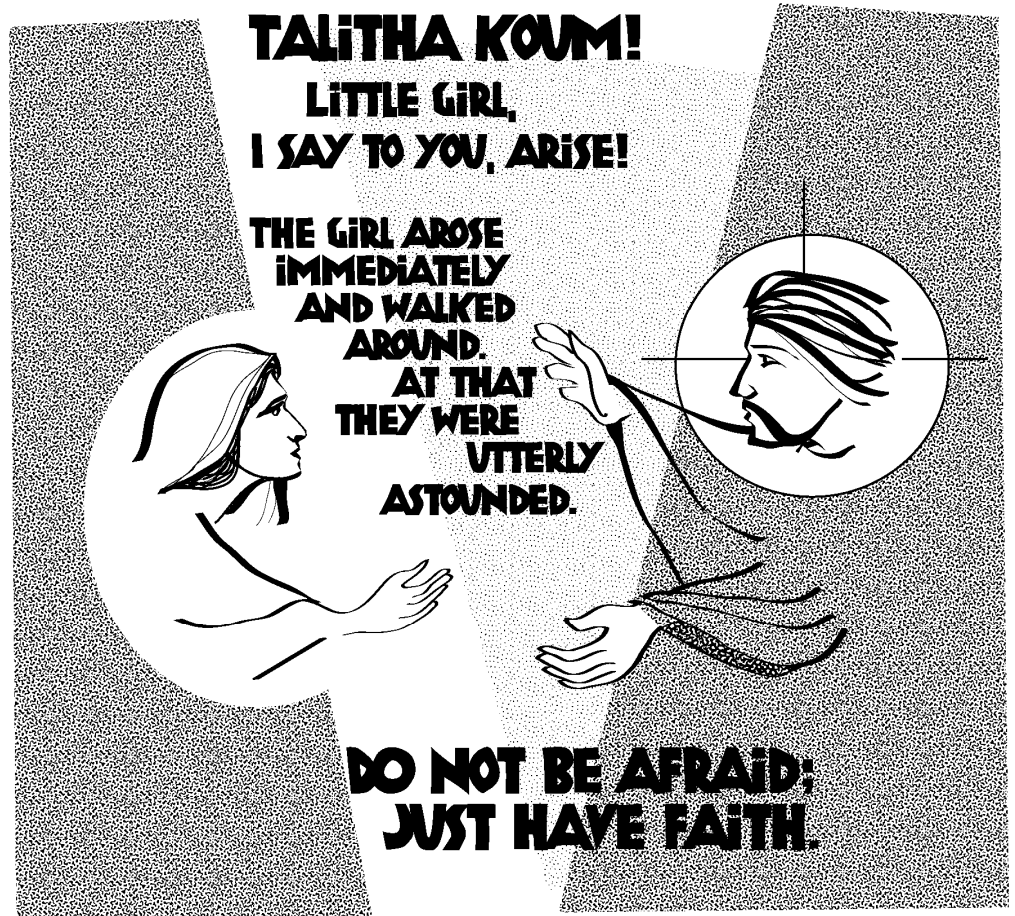

FROM THE DESK OF FR. TIM: At this time we acknowledge “Fortnight For Freedom.” Religious liberty is protected in the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and in federal and state laws. Religious liberty includes more than to go to Mass on Sunday or pray the rosary at home; it also encompasses our ability to contribute freely to the common good of all Americans.

The First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution states the following: “Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; on the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for the redress of grievances.”

We have the right to our faith. Many families today do not practice their faith, not realizing how important this right is in our lives today. Our Faith is what sustains us, it is how we live out our faith by loving one another and our God and reconciling our differences. If we cannot do that, then we have nothing in our lives that will gain us the salvation that Jesus promises us.

Enjoy the freedom that is guaranteed to us by our Constitution before we lose these rights. Stand up and be counted for as patriotic Americans.

Parish Health Notes—One in five American adults will have a diagnosable mental health condition in any given year. **50 percent** of Americans will meet the criteria for a mental health condition sometime in their life, and half of those people will develop conditions by the age of 14.
