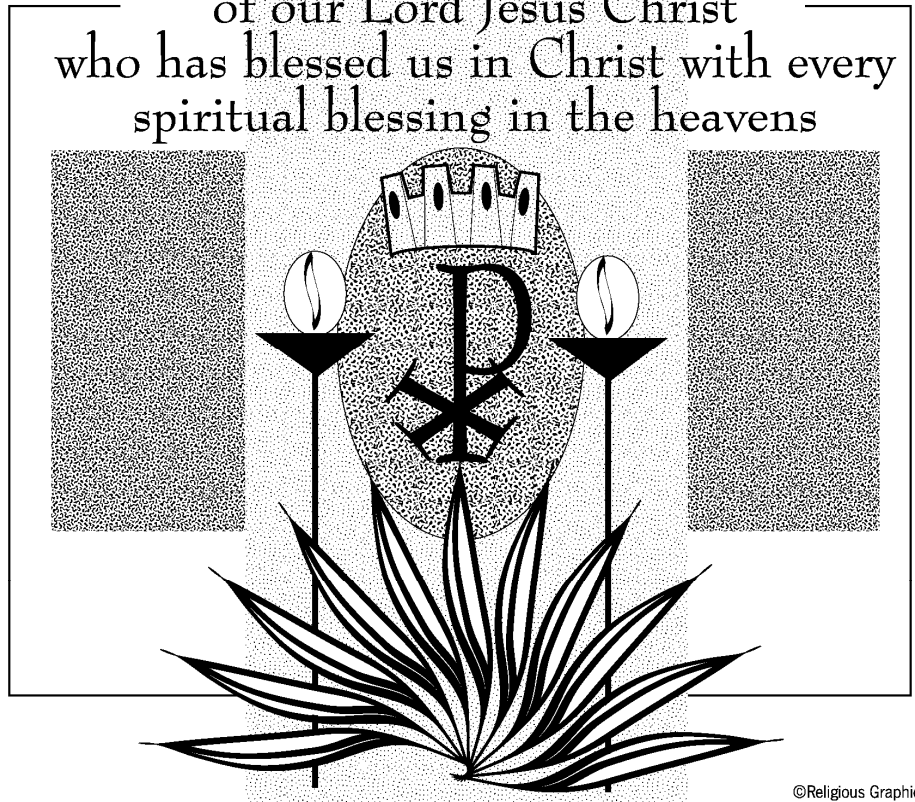

Parish Health Notes—*How to prevent tick bites.* Ticks can spread disease, including Lyme disease. Protect yourself: Use insect repellent that contains 20–30% DEET (10–30% in children less than 2 years.) Take a shower as soon as you can after being outdoors. Look for ticks on your body. Ticks can hide under the armpits, behind the knees, in the hair, and in the groin.

How to remove a tick

1. If a tick is attached to you, use fine-tipped tweezers to grasp the tick at the surface of your skin.
2. Pull the tick straight up and out. Don't twist or jerk the tick—this can cause the mouth parts to break off and stay in the skin.
3. Clean the bite and your hands with rubbing alcohol, an iodine scrub, or soap and water.
4. You may get a small bump or redness that goes away in 1-2 days, like a mosquito bit. This is not a sign that you have Lyme disease.

***See a doctor** if you develop a fever, a rash, severe fatigue, facial paralysis, or joint pain within 30 days of being bitten by a tick. Be sure to tell your doctor about your tick bite.

St. Pat's Part-time Maintenance Person Needed—Seeking an individual to work 20-25 hrs a week helping with maintenance of the church grounds and buildings.
