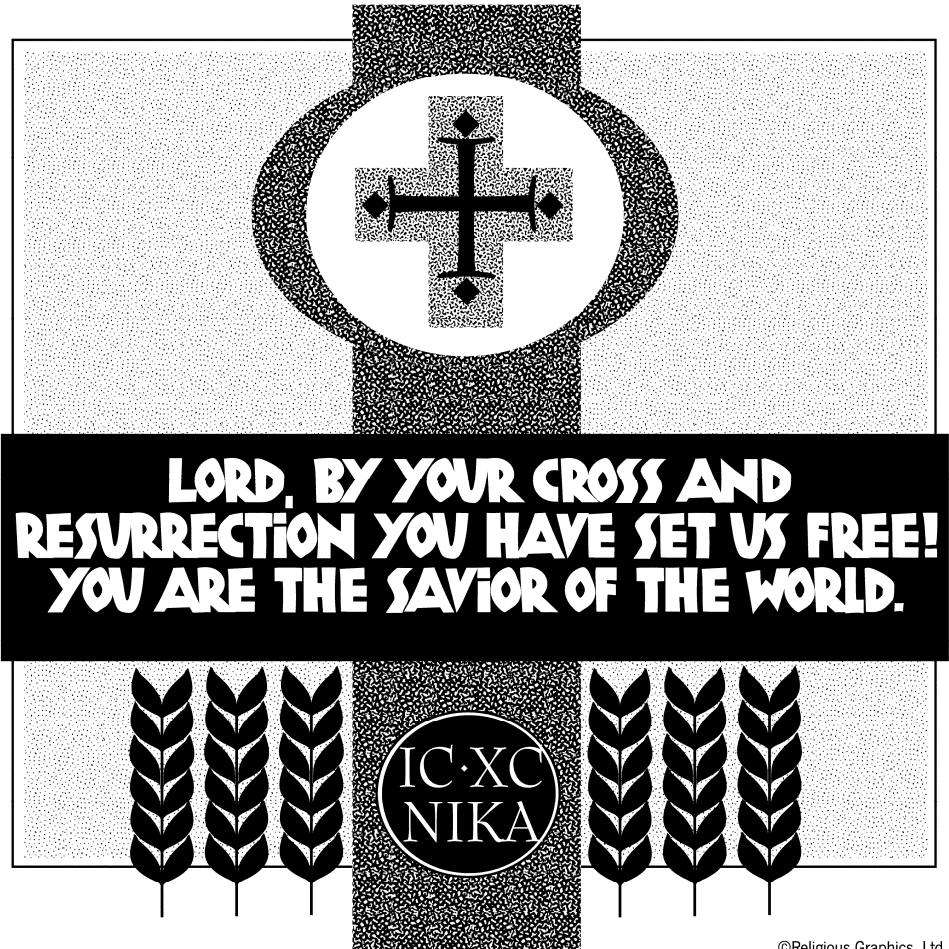

Parish Health Notes—Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death in the US. There is 1 death by suicide every 13 minutes. Know the warning signs. Talking about feeling trapped or being a burden. Acting anxious or agitated. Withdrawn or isolated. Extreme mood swings. If you are concerned a friend or family member may be suicidal, listening to what they say in a non-judgmental way and letting them know you care can have a significant impact. Isolation increases the risk of suicide and having strong social connections is protective against it. Being there for someone who has become disconnected can be life-saving.
