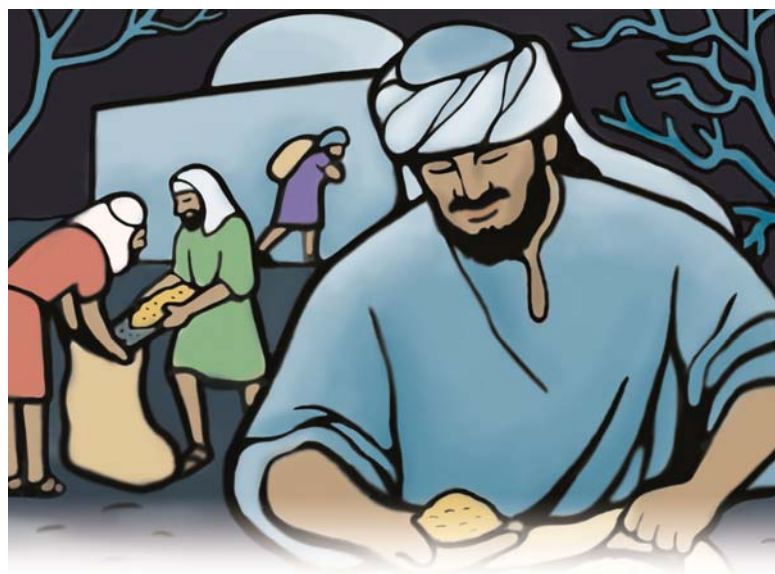

Parish Health Notes *Swimming Pool Safety*

- Tragically, over 200 young children drown in backyard swimming pools each year. Keep children under **active** supervision at all times and provide a safe and fun environment for swimming by doing the following:
- *Designate a responsible person to watch the water when people are in the pool—never allow anyone to swim alone and stay within an arm's reach of young children. *Establish and enforce rules and safe behaviors such as "no diving", "stay away from drain covers", and "swim with a buddy." *Keep your pool or hot tub water clean and clear. When not in use, place a safety cover on the pool and remove any ladders or steps used for access. *Surround your pool with a 4-foot high fence or barrier with a self-closing, self-latching gate and install a pool alarm for added safety. *Have young or inexperienced swimmers wear a life jacket. *Ensure everyone in the home knows how to respond to aquatic emergencies by having appropriate safety equipment and enrolling everyone in water orientation safety, first aid and CPR, and swimming courses through the Red Cross, a local YMCA, or other community organization.
