If directed at us, we are in good company according to today's Gospel. The relatives of Jesus said that about him when he came home. The reason for such a judgement is not entirely clear. Is it because the crowds that followed him disrupted their way of life? Or was it because the scribes from Jerusalem were saying that he was possessed? We might ask ourselves what might prompt us to respond in such a way. Is someone living the Gospel in a way that challenges us and we feel uncomfortable? Are we being asked to change in a way that we resist?
