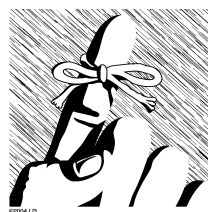
God, help me to stay close to you so that I am ready for my tests.

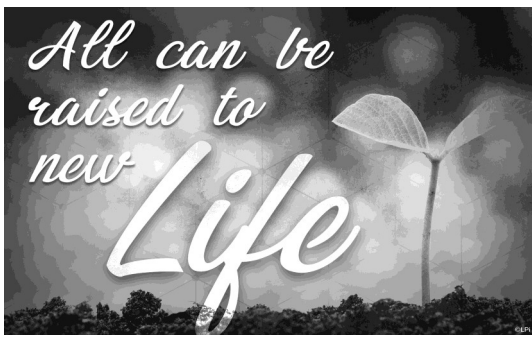

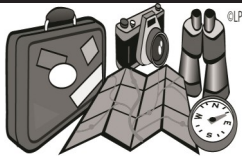
