Parish Health Notes

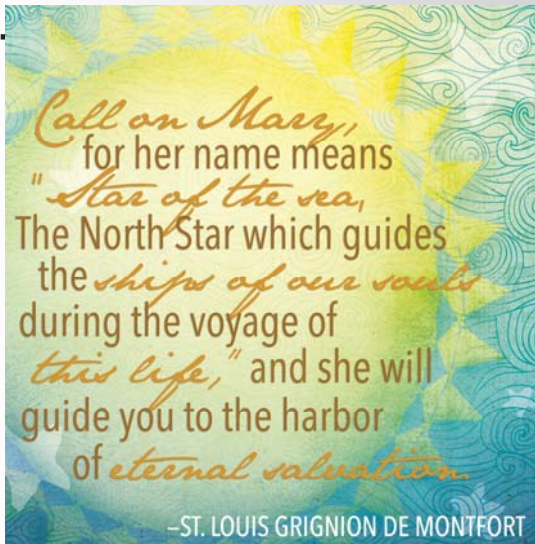


- *Pokemon Go has taken the world by storm.* Here are some tips to stay safe!
