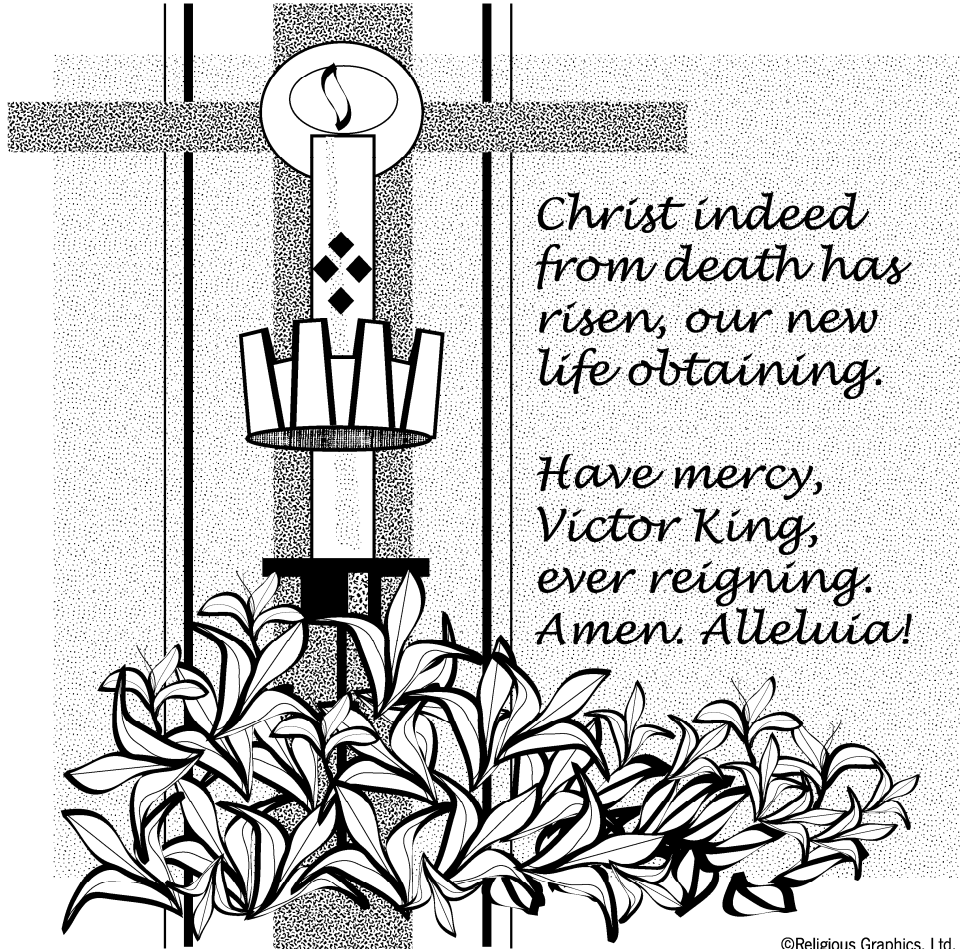

**Divine Mercy Sunday—Join us at St. Patrick’s April 12, in the Holy Family Chapel, to celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday at 1:30 pm.** On February 22, 1931, Jesus appeared to Sr. Faustina with rays radiating from His heart and said, “Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus I trust in You.” During the course of Jesus’ revelations to Saint Faustina on the Divine Mercy He asked on numerous occasions that a feast day be dedicated to the Divine Mercy and that this feast be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. “I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. **Parish Health Notes**—Sleep hygiene is a variety of different practices that are necessary to have normal, quality nighttime sleep and full daytime alertness. The most important sleep hygiene measure is to maintain a regular wake and sleep pattern seven days a week. *Exercise* can promote good sleep. *Food* can be disruptive right before sleep. Ensure adequate exposure to *natural light*. Establish a regular relaxing *bedtime routine*. Associate *your bed* with sleep. Make sure that *the sleep environment* is pleasant and relaxing. Avoid use of *caffeine, nicotine and alcohol* too close to bedtime. *Why is it important to practice good sleep hygiene?* Sleep hygiene is important for everyone. A good sleep hygiene routine promotes healthy sleep and daytime alertness. Good sleep hygiene practices can prevent the development of sleep problems and disorders. Notably, insufficient sleep has been linked to the development and management of a number of chronic diseases and conditions, including diabetes, cardiovascular disease, obesity and depression. If you're taking too long to fall asleep, or awakening during the night, you should consider revising your bedtime habits. [www.sleepfoundation.org](http://www.sleepfoundation.org).
