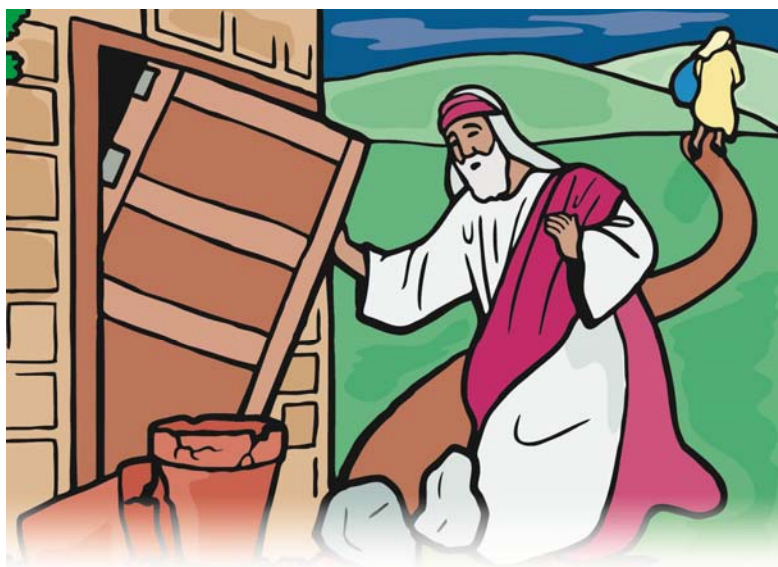

## Parish Health Notes

- Keeping a pet safe from the summer heat can reduce feelings of stress, anxiety and worry of the owner. Here are some helpful hints to help you feel at ease and to keep your pet safe. When playing outside, find some shade and get your pet out of the heat. Signs of heat stroke in pets include excessive panting, dark or bright red tongue and gums, staggering, stupor, seizures, diarrhea or vomiting. Pets with normally heavy coats, and those with heart or respiratory problems are at high risk for heat stroke. If you suspect heat stroke in your pet, seek veterinary attention immediately! Use cool water, not ice water, to cool your pet. Very cold water will cause constriction of the blood vessels and impede cooling. Offer ice cubes for the animal to lick on until you can reach your veterinarian. Just because your animal is cooled and "appears" OK, do not assume everything is fine. Internal organs such as liver, kidneys, brain, etc., are affected by body temperature elevation, and blood tests and veterinary examination are needed to assess this. 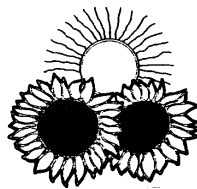

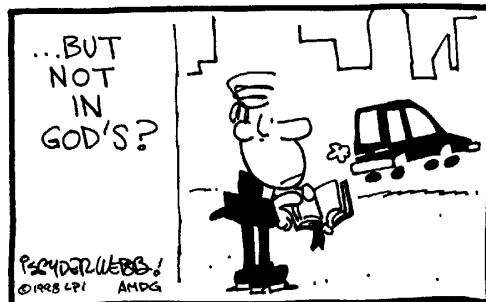
